Purpose of IRHA Student Scholarships

Rural areas throughout the country face disproportionate shortages of health care professionals in comparison to urban and suburban areas. In fact, although rural areas within the United States are home to approximately 20 percent of the country's population, less than 9 percent of physicians practice in non-metropolitan counties. Professional shortages also exist for nurses, dentists, pharmacists, radiology and laboratory technicians, and mental health professionals, just to name a few.

Methods that help address this problem include:

- 1) Development and implementation of training programs for health care professionals in rural areas;
- 2) Implementation of telehealth or distance learning techniques;
- 3) Collaboration with institutions of higher learning to address maldistribution; and
- 4) Collaboration with local, state, and national organizations that are addressing rural recruitment
