### Greene County General Hospital Announces Increased Minimum Wages

Linton, IN - During the April 2022 Board of Trustees meeting, the Board voted unanimously to increase Greene County General Hospital's minimum wage to \$15 per hour. Current employees making less than the new minimum wage will increase to \$15 per hour, or more, beginning May 1, 2022. Employees hired at the minimum wage after May 1, 2022, will be hired at the new rate.

Increasing the minimum wage for employees was important to GCGH's Board of Trustees. Board President Nathan Abrams (Greene County Commissioner) says, "the Board values GCGH employees and wanted to not only retain our current exceptional employees but attract candidates to fill our many open positions."

GCGH is hiring full-time, part-time, and PRN employees at the new \$15 per hour rate for Food Services Aides, Cooks, Environmental Services Technicians, Patient Access Representatives, and Patient Care Technicians. Experience and education also factor in for hiring at rates above the minimum wage. ## Rush Memorial Hospital Offers New CMA Course

February 16 was the first day of class for the new 12-week Certified Clinical Medical Assistant course currently being offered at Rush Memorial Hospital. The class, which is being offered in conjunction with Ivy Tech Community College, conveys 6 hours of college credit and carries an NHA certification. The course is scheduled to end on May 11. Graduation for the 9 participants will be held on May 20.

Brian Bane, VP of Human Resources at RMH, has wanted to offer this course for some time, and he is very happy to see his goal fulfilled. He said, "This course will help us in two ways. First, it helps us meet hiring goals in a tight job market. Secondly, it gives our employees another avenue for personal development."

The implementation of the new course was facilitated by Savanna Fox, the new Director of Training and Development at RMH. Savanna is well acquainted with adult education, having managed the Family Medicine Residency program at both Franciscan and IU Health.

According to Savanna, most of the students in the program are non-clinical employees who want to receive clinical training. In exchange for CCMA education, which is paid for by the hospital, they have agreed to work at RMH for at least one year after the completion of the course.



## Greene County General Hospital Hosted Car Seat Check Clinic

Linton, IN - Greene County General Hospital and the Perinatal Navigator from Healthy Start Communities that C.A.R.E. offered a free car seat inspection by a certified child passenger safety technician on April 22. A total of 11 car seats were checked, and 8 new seats were presented to families.



## TeamOrtho Orthopedics and Sports Medicine Center and MyClinics

Greene County General Hospital's TeamOrtho Orthopedics and Sports Medicine Center and My Clinics' providers traveled to each school in Greene County to provide free sports physicals to students while they were in school. Over 500 free sports physicals were provided to students.



## Rural Health Clinic – Reopened in Brook, Newton County Blessing and Dedication

Franciscan Health Rensselaer operates the Brook Health Center in Brook, Indiana. The Clinic was temporarily moved to the Hospital in 2019 while demolition and a rebuild could occur. Delays related to COVID caused the temporary location to extend its stay. In the Fall of 2021, the old building was fully demolished, and the new construction began. After a very patient staff and very loyal patients spent nearly three years “displaced,” the day came to re-open the center back in its original location of Brook, Indiana.

On February 17, 2022, a small group of stakeholders joined Carlos Vasquez, Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, for a welcome and opening remarks. Sr. Chery Dazey, Director of Mission Integration, conducted a recommitment promise. A reading was provided by Kari Goodman, Director of Patient Care Services. Sarah Myers, NP, shared the prayer of the faithful. Fr. Joshua Bennett, Pastor of the St. Michael the Archangel Pastorate, provided a blessing of the rooms and building. The patients are delighted to have their healthcare close to home. Franciscan Brook Health Center staff is grateful to continue to serve the evolving healthcare needs of families in Newton County.

## Achieving Birth Equity Statewide Conference

Indiana Rural Health Association's Connecting Kids to Coverage-IN (CKC-IN) program recently attended the inaugural Achieving Birth Equity conference in South Bend on April 14. The conference was intended for providers and social services with a focus on maternal and infant mortality outcomes. Disparities in birth experiences and outcomes was discussed with data demonstrating the need for improvement. IRHA's CKC-IN team provided an exhibit table with information displayed about the program's available services. The team also presented a breakout session during the all-day conference entitled, "Medicaid 101; Before, During, and After Pregnancy." The presentation was in collaboration with all five Managed Care Entities in the State of Indiana. The presenters explained Indiana Medicaid programs, eligibility criteria for each program, and benefits offered to members through each Managed Care Entity. The presentation was offered during all four breakout sessions throughout the day and was well attended. 

#### Take Two! The 2nd InROC MAT Waiver Training is June 27, 2022!

The Indiana Rural Opioid Consortium (InROC) is hosting Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Waiver trainings to help boost the number of professionals providing this service in Indiana. The next virtual training will be held on **June 27, 2022, 12:30-4:30pm EST**.

Dr. Emily Zarse, MD, will present a 4-hour required training virtually; and then attendees will complete the additional 4 hours at their own pace. Upon completion, attendees will receive a certificate to then apply for a MAT Waiver. There is no cost to attend this training.

While this training is primarily aimed at physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants who want to become a Buprenorphine prescriber, it is not restricted to providers who want to become waivered only. Participants will get CME credit for attending.
