INDIANA TELEHEALTH NETWORK

Connects healthcare providers with funding from the FCC for high-speed broadband access.

HEALTHY MINDS, HEALTHY LIVES

Conducts workshops to address mental health stressors and crisis response.

INDIANA STATEWIDE RURAL HEALTH NETWORK

Provides support to rural hospitals and their RHCs to coordinate, improve and expand access to quality essential services, and enhance healthcare delivery.

HEALTHY START COMMUNITIES THAT C.A.R.E.

Provides screening, support, referrals, treatment, and education for expectant mothers, infants, and families

INDIANA TOBACCO CESSATION

Provides outreach to unfounded counties for cessation systems change to enroll rural providers in TPC Preferred Networks and provide tobacco use treatment resources to RHCs, CAHs, and other healthcare facilities.

CONNECTING KIDS TO COVERAGE - INDIANA

Assists families in finding healthcare coverage in Indiana through licensed Indiana Navigators.

UPPER MIDWEST TELEHEALTH RESOURCE CENTER

Provides a comprehensive set of telehealth clinical and technical assistance services leveraged into products of lasting value to rural providers.

COMMUNITY PARAMEDICINE

Uses paramedics as physician extenders to provide care in the patient home. IRHA currently has two programs that provide maternal and child health, chronic disease management, and hospital readmission prevention services.
