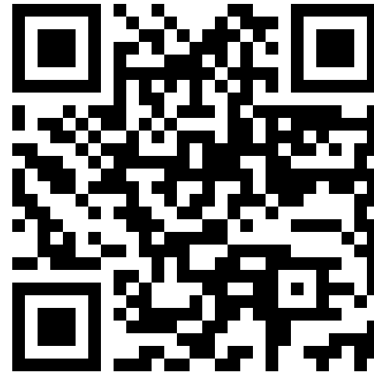

Mock Surveys

Mock surveys are key to having a successful initial certification or recertification survey. IRHA's Rural Health Clinic Network Director has obtained the Certified Rural Health Clinic Professional certification from the National Association of Rural Health Clinics and has attended trainings to offer the most realistic and robust mock surveys possible for IRHA members who have surveys with the Indiana Department of Health, The Compliance Team, or Quad A (AAAASF).

Mock surveys are included for RHCs owned by a hospital that is a member of the Indiana Statewide Rural Health Network (InSRHN). A mock survey includes an in-person one-day survey, as well as a post-mock survey report for the RHC to review. Limit one mock survey per RHC per year.
