SUPPORTING A HEALTHY INDIANA

The Connecting Kids to Coverage-Indiana program has helped **1,534 Indiana children and 2,842 Indiana adults** (ages 19-64) newly enroll into Medicaid since the program's start in June of 2019.

The Indiana Rural Opioid Consortium (InROC) has **screened over 16,000 individuals for Substance Use Disorders**.

The **Indiana Rural Communities Collaborative (IRCC)** is connecting rural health entities to ensure a collaborative approach to **fighting COVID-19**.

For more than 11 years, IRHA has been a **statewide partner with IDOH/TPC** to assess current healthcare facilities regarding tobacco use and most recently to build a translatable model for **tobacco dependence treatment** in health systems.

TELEHEALTH

- The Indiana Telehealth Network has secured **over \$27 million dollars** in funding from the FCC for high-speed broadband access for our health care providers.
- The Upper Midwest Telehealth Resource Center **answered 1,125 technical assistance requests** related to telehealth from 2017-2020.
- The Crossroads Partnership for Telehealth has provided over **4,000 tele-behavioral health visits** over the past three years to over **1,050 patients**.
- The Indiana Rural Schools Clinic Network (IRSCN) has **implemented 40 rural school-based telehealth clinics** in Indiana served by 18 provider groups.



INFANT & MATERNAL MORTALITY

- Healthy Start Communities that C.A.R.E.** has served 611 pregnant women, 1139 non-pregnant women, infants, and children up to 18 months old, and 322 fathers since inception of program in 2019 - **a total of 2,072 lives touched** by the program.
- The **Rural Maternity Care Coordination (RMCC) Program** is designed to coordinate maternity care through establishment of a sustainable **patient center medical home** in partnership with 4 clinics in the rural Indiana counties of Putnam, Owen, Sullivan and Greene.
- The **Community Paramedicine Program** seeks to use Community Paramedics as an extension of the physician office or hospital to **improve the health outcomes** for prenatal and postpartum women and infants.



EDUCATION

- The FLEX Lunch & Learn Series hosts at least **36 presentations per year** and is nearing **10k views on our YouTube channel**.
- The Healthy Minds, Healthy Lives program will host **statewide workshops** to provide rural communities the tools they need to recognize stress, related **mental health issues**, and mental health crisis'.
